<u>History Committee</u> – The Secretary reported on activities since the October meeting, noting that November 1st marked the 50th anniversary of the dedication of the department's newest fire station at Hartford Turnpike and Ridge Road, at which HFRA chaplain Rev. Owen Sanderson was also sworn in as the department's chaplain.

NEW BUSINESS – Dave Beaton read a letter from Chief Merwede acknowledging the establishment of a scholarship in memory of our deceased brother, Ff. Sam Jones, to be given to a Hamden High School senior of color desiring a career in EMS to obtain EMT training through Yale-New Haven Hospital. Sam was the department's first African American career member, serving on the department from May 1961 until his retirement in November 1990. The Association will acknowledge its thanks to the Jones family and to Chief Merwede.

GOOD OF THE ASSOCIATION – Bill Fitzmaurice noted that today marked the first anniversary of his son's swearing in as a member of the department.

The Chair thanked Dave Beaton for attending today and for his participation in the meeting, as well as all others who attended with Zoom. He asked that everyone who attended today to please email the Secretary to acknowledge that they attended because not everyone is visible on his screen.

The Chair announced that the next meeting will be an evening meeting during the second week of June, date to be announced as we near that date. It is hoped that we will once again be able to meet in person by then. As always, the Secretary will notify all members at least one week before the meeting.

The Secretary noted that the five members we have lost since October 2019 will be honored at the October 2021 meeting, perhaps with a dinner. All families have been notified well in advance of the occasion on which their loved one will be honored.

Following adjournment, the Secretary played the 2021 edition of "We Remember," a memorial video tribute that features the photos of all deceased career members of the department since 1918. The video also includes all pre-1942 chief officers, "paid drivers," and the Co. 4 volunteer firefighter who was killed in a pumper accident while responding to a call. The video is available on the HFRA website.
